## **Ministry Trainee**

We are looking for a Ministry Trainee to join the team at St Peter's (ideally from September 2026). This is an opportunity to develop ministry skills, deepen Bible knowledge, grow in godly character and gain ministry experience in a range of areas.

**2026 update:** *We are currently actively seeking to plant/revitalise a church elsewhere in London and so any Ministry Trainee role will involve a willingness to carry out the below duties either at St Peter's or at the plant church. Depending on the needs and progress of the plant, your time may be divided between the two churches. Overall line management will also be determined by where the majority of your time is based.*

**Principal Duties:** Your time will be divided roughly equally between the following 3 areas: one area of specific ministry involvement (Discipleship, Women's Work, Evangelism & Youth & Children), practical service & theological training provided through the PT Cornhill Scheme and Co-Mission Ministry workshop.

There is an expectation that whichever area of ministry you are involved with, that you will attend and serve at the St. Peter's Church weekend away, REVIVE (the annual Co-Mission weekend away) and a summer camp that St. Peter's is involved in.

The appointment is a paid, full time role for 2 years.

The candidate will be a committed Christian, a self starter, with good organisational skills and be able to communicate effectively.
