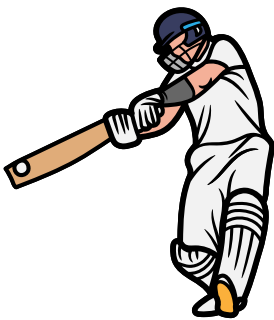
Know some **children** in nursery - year 2? Invite them along to the **FAB Club Light party** on **Wednesday 2nd November 3:45-4:45pm**.
